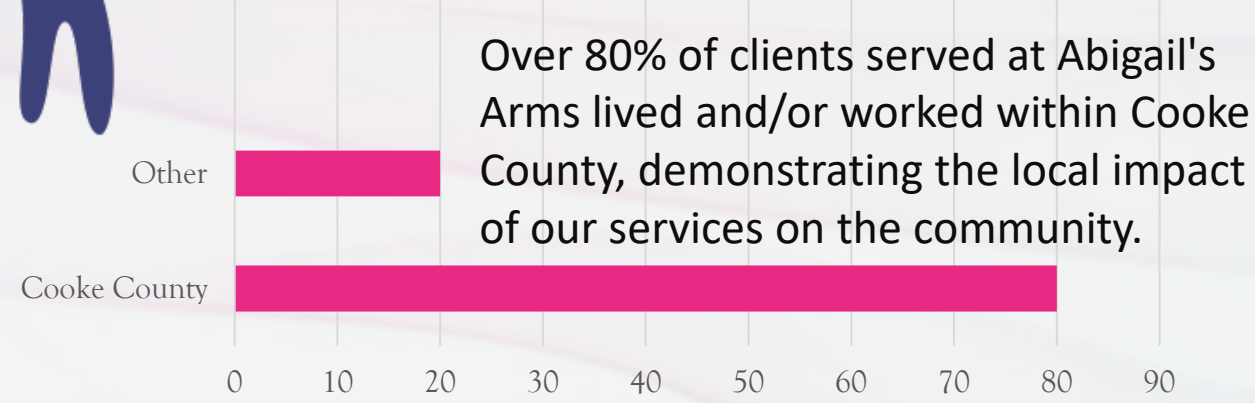
Total Individuals Served in 2023: 1278

Each month, our agency welcomes an average of 68 new individuals seeking support, while 39 individuals return regularly for case management, therapy, and other follow-up services and support.

46% of clients were under the age of 18, highlighting the significant impact of violence on youth in our community.
